FAQ About Gate Transponders

How do I get the entrance gate transponder?

The transponders are distributed by Supervisor Pennington of the District (phone is 407-757-3137). The Gate Access Form is located in Community Documents under the Documents Tab of the website. Please fill this form out completely, along with a **4 digit code of your choice**, one that you will remember, to allow you access in the event you don't have your transponder with you. This code also allows your guests and/or vendors entrance if needed.

PLEASE NOTE: You must press the # sign first **before** entering the 4 digit code.

How many transponders do I get?

Each Property Owner in the District will receive two (2) transponders at no cost for gate access through the Gate Access System. Transponders in excess of two (2) are \$50 per transponder. Property Owners can only receive a maximum of four (4) transponders total, inclusive of the two provided at no cost.

In the event a Property Owner requires a replacement transponder, the fee is \$25 per transponder, and the prior transponder will be immediately deactivated.

Where is the transponder placed on the vehicle?

Place the transponder in the top right hand corner of the windshield.

How do I let visitors in at the gate?

Visitors need to look your name up on the keypad and call the phone number listed there. When you answer, you will press the number 9. This will open the gate. You can then hang up. It is imperative that the Gate Access Form be completely filled out with the phone number you want listed in the keypad system.
